Mr. SCHMITT introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to instruct Inspectors General to report to Congress on social media communications.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Transparency in Bu-
5 reaucratic Communications Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. INSPECTOR GENERAL ACT OF 1978.**

7 Section 405(b) of title 5, United States Code, is
8 amended—

9 (1) in paragraph (21)(B), by striking “and” at
10 the end;

1 (2) in paragraph (22)(B), by striking the period
2 at the end and inserting “; and”; and

3 (3) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(23) a detailed description of the contents and
5 particular circumstances of any communication, or
6 attempted communication, between the establish-
7 ment and any internet computer service, information
8 content provider, or access software provider (as de-
9 fined under section 230(f) of the Communications
10 Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 230(f)), including—

11 “(A) communications regarding content
12 moderation (as described under section
13 230(c)(2) of the Communications Act of 1934
14 (47 U.S.C. 230(c)(2));

15 “(B) user content, including posts, photos,
16 and videos; and

17 “(C) any other communications relating to
18 the internet computer service, information con-
19 tent provider, or access software provider’s data
20 inputs, algorithms, modeling and simulation
21 processes, analysis tools, or any related tool.”.

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
