extending the provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of isobutanol
originating in the Russian Federation

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2720/93 imposed a provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of isobutanol originating in the Russian Federation.
2. The examination of the facts has not yet been completed and the exporters raised no objections to the extension of the provisional anti-dumping duty.
3. Accordingly, pursuant to Article 11 (5) of Council Regulation No 2423/88, the Commission hereby submits a proposal for a Council Regulation extending the validity of the provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of isobutanol originating in the Russian Federation for an additional period of two months.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2423/88 of 11 July 1988 on protection against dumped or subsidised imports from countries not members of the European Community⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 11 thereof,

Having regard to the Commission proposal,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2720/93⁽²⁾ imposed a provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of isobutanol originating in the Russian Federation;

Whereas examination of the facts has not yet been completed and the exporters have raised no objection to the extension of the provisional anti-dumping duty.

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The validity of the provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of isobutanol originating in the Russian Federation imposed by Regulation (EEC) No 2720/93 is hereby extended for a period of two months. It shall cease to apply if, before the expiry of that period, the Council adopts definitive measures or the proceeding is terminated under Article 9 of Regulation (EEC) No 2423/88.

Article 2

This shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
