GROUNDS

On 7 July 1982 the Commission sent the Council a proposal for a Decision amending Council Decision 79/783/EEC of 11 September 1979 adopting a multiannual programme (1979 to 1983) in the field of data processing (COM(82)356 final).

The purpose of the proposal was to extend the second part of the multiannual data-processing programme, which deals with the promotion of data-processing applications and software, by supporting selected projects of strategic importance.

On 15 April 1983 Parliament adopted a resolution endorsing the Commission proposal.

The proposal is now being examined in the Permanent Representatives Committee, and the Council is expected to come to a decision by the end of the year.

To allow utilization of the appropriations for Item 7702 entered in Chapter 100, the Commission proposes that they should be transferred to the appropriate heading.

The transfer will enable appropriations to be kept available to implement extension of the programme once this has been approved by the Council.
