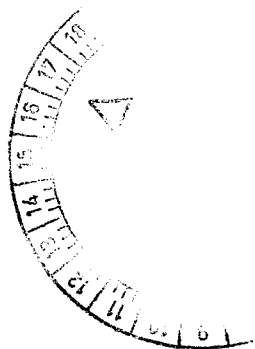

GROUNDS

Item 6704 - European Historical Monuments and Sites Fund - was created on Parliament's initiative when the 1983 budget was adopted in order to make a Community contribution to the conservation of monuments and sites to be selected in the various Member States in turn. Unfortunately, this item received only a token entry in the 1983 budget. However the Commission has proposed an appropriation of 400 000 ECU in the preliminary draft budget for 1984.

The Commission has already received several applications for financial aid towards emergency conservation projects.

The Commission will set out the main arguments when this proposal for a transfer is examined.

Given the present state of budget funds, it is impossible to satisfy all of these applications at once. The Commission considers that it would be in the Community's interest to grant aid, however small, to a few of the most worthwhile projects. These projects are of the type "pilot-projects".

The Commission therefore requests the transfer of 100.000 ECU from Chapter 101 - Contingency reserve - to Item 6704 - European Historical Monuments and Sites Fund.
