GROUNDS

On 15 June 1973 Italy and Yugoslavia concluded a bilateral agreement permitting Italian fishermen to fish in Yugoslav waters in the Adriatic in return for payment.

In its resolution of 3 November 1976, the Council stated that appropriate Community agreements should be negotiated to preserve the rights of Community fishermen to fish in the waters of non-member countries.

At the same time, the Council took a decision authorizing the extension of the bilateral agreement between Italy and Yugoslavia, to 31 December 1977 at the latest, to allow time for the negotiation of a Community agreement. In the absence of such an agreement, the Council authorized extension of the bilateral agreement on a number of subsequent occasions, and most recently up to 31 December 1980.

It finally became clear that Yugoslavia did not wish to conclude an agreement.

In its decision of 16 June 1980 authorizing renewal of the agreement until 31 December 1980 the Council agreed that 80% payment (Lit 640 million) should be met from the Community budget.

On 14 February 1983 the Italian authorities applied to the Commission for reimbursement of that amount (equivalent to 480 000 ECU at the rate of exchange prevailing in April 1983) to be charged to budget Article 420 (Reimbursements due under agreements on fishing in the Adriatic), which in 1983 had a token entry.

To make this reimbursement, it is proposed to transfer 490 000 ECU to Article 420 from the 4 260 000 ECU entered in Chapter 100 for Articles 421 and 422. The figure of 490 000 ECU includes a margin to allow for any appreciation of lira before the Lit 640 million have been paid.

There is no entry in Chapter 100 for Article 420 because it was expected that the reimbursement to Italy would have been made in 1982. However, current estimates suggest that the appropriation of 4.26 million ECU will suffice for Article 420 as well. If this is not so, the appropriations will be increased by appropriate budgetary means.
