I.

1. In continuation of the systematic examination of Community secondary legislation in accordance with the brief received from the Council, the Commission has undertaken with the Greek Delegation a supplementary examination of the new general acts adopted by the institutions of the Communities since the initial examination was carried out in the following fields:

Transport
Environment and Consumer Protection
Taxation
Economic and Financial Affairs
Rules on Competition
Energy (EEC and ECSC)
Research and Scientific Information (EEC)
Euratom (Acts of the European Atomic Energy Community).

The supplementary examination covered acts in force on 1 January 1979.

As in the initial sectoral examinations, the Greek Delegation has also been informed of all the acts adopted by the Council or the Commission in the fields in question which do not form part of Community secondary legislation proper and are not legally binding on the Member States or their nationals (recommendations, resolutions and other internal decisions) but are relevant to the development or direction of Community activities. Such acts do not, of course, give rise to any problem of adaptation and for this reason are not included in the annexes to this report.

2. Subject to the observations made below, the results of this examination are set out in the three annexes to this report:

Annex I lists the new acts which do not require any technical adaptation;

Annex II lists the acts in respect of which technical adaptations are necessary and gives, where possible, the wording of those adaptations;

Annex III lists the acts in respect of which the Greek Delegation has indicated that it reserves the right to request that their application or implementation be wholly or partially deferred within the framework of transitional measures.

II

The examination of the acts in question gives rise to the following additional observations:

1. As a result of this first supplementary examination it has been found that certain acts in force at the time of the initial examination of each of the fields in question and included in that examination have subsequently lapsed or have been amended by new acts adopted since then.

Where such acts were listed in the reports on the results of the initial examinations among the acts requiring technical adaptations to take account of Greece's accession (see Annex II to the preceding reports), the adaptations indicated should obviously be corrected if necessary or rescinded. These cases are dealt with in Annex II to this report, which lists the corrections to be made to the conclusions of the preceding reports.

2. TAXATION

(a) The Council Directive of 30 April 1968 on a common method for calculating the average rates provided for in Article 97 of the Treaty (Directive 68/221/EEC, OJ L 115, 18.5.1968, p. 14), the examination of which was deferred at the time of the initial examination (see Third Report, COM(77)57 final of 8 March 1977), was also looked at, but this text presents a problem of substance that must be resolved in the negotiations, namely whether the provisions of the Directive will apply to the average rates in force in Greece at the time of accession or only to subsequent adjustments of those rates. The text may require technical adaptation in the light of the decision to be taken in this connection.

The possibility of such an adaptation is therefore indicated between square brackets in Annex II to this report.

(b) The Greek Delegation has requested that Mount Athos be excluded from the territorial field of application of the Sixth Council Directive of 17 May 1977 (77/388/EEC) on the harmonization of the laws of the Member States relating to turnover taxes - Common system of value added tax: uniform basis of assessment (OJ No L 145, 13.6.1977, p. 1).

This request is linked with the special status that Greece wishes to reserve for Mount Athos, notably as regards customs and tax matters.

Accordingly, the adaptation which the request would necessitate - the inclusion of Mount Athos among the territories listed in Article 3(2) of Directive 77/388/EEC - is indicated between square brackets in Annex II to this report; the adoption or otherwise of this adaptation will be determined by the outcome of the substantive negotiations which are in progress concerning the status of Mount Athos in relation to obligations under Community law.

3. ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL AFFAIRS

The supplementary examination took place at a particularly sensitive time as regards economic and monetary matters. Certain acts requiring technical adaptations will themselves be amended, if not repealed, by the decisions establishing the EMS. The results of the meeting held on 15 January will be cancelled out to a large extent, therefore, and a third meeting with the Greek Delegation will be needed. However, the meeting of 15 January enabled Commission officials to describe to their Greek colleagues the main features of the future monetary system.

Certain acts relating to credit machinery (short-term monetary support and medium-term financial assistance) require technical adaptations to determine the extent of Greek participation in this machinery. The Commission has prepared proposals, which will be transmitted to the Council after the Monetary Committee and the Board of Governors of the EMCF have given their opinions. These proposals can be negotiated with the Greek Delegation at a coming meeting.

The inclusion of the drachma in the EUA basket is still a substantive issue that will have to be settled in the negotiations. Consequently the acts that may require technical adaptations are not mentioned for the time being in any of the annexes to this report.

A particular problem will arise in connection with the preparation of the fifth medium-term economic policy programme, which should normally cover the period 1980-85. Work on drawing up the programme should begin this year. The Greek Delegation has expressed the wish that Greece be associated with the technical preparatory work involved. No difficulty of principle has been raised on the Commission side, but the cooperation procedure would have to be defined.

4. RESEARCH (EEC and EAEC)

A general question was raised by the Greek Delegation in connection with the detailed arrangements for Greece's participation in or contribution to the various research programmes (in particular concerted action projects and direct action projects) decided on by the Council that are under way at the time of its accession.

The Greek Delegation has expressed interest in participating in the implementation of these programmes as soon as possible. With a view to making a start on preparations for its participation and coordinating in the meantime the parallel projects which it has undertaken at national level in the same fields, Greece would also like to be kept regularly informed of the implementation and results of the various joint research projects under way or planned.

Greece's request, however, will in no case necessitate adaptation of the Council's decisions adopting research programmes.

In the case of direct action projects carried out by the JCR, the problem of Greek "participation" obviously does not arise.

Decisions relating to indirect projects carried out under contract do not involve any duty or any obligation on the part of the Member States or their research bodies. As it is the Commission's job to award such contracts, decisions relating to programmes cannot be affected by the possible choice of Greek contractors.

There is no need for such procedure even in the case of concerted action projects, which are confined to coordination of national research programmes and which, at first sight, would appear to involve an adaptation of Annex I to the relevant decisions relating to the programme to make room possibly for Greek research. This Annex has indicative value only and secondly, given the structure of these projects, each Member State undertaking research in a field in which there is concerted action, but after adoption of such action, has to submit this research to Community coordination, without any revision of Annex I being necessary. The same principles should apply to Greece.

Accordingly, all the acts relating to such projects are listed in Annex I to this report.

Moreover, it goes without saying that the general procedure of information and consultation which will be envisaged during the interim period (from the signature of the accession instruments until the entry into force of accession) will apply to new acts that the Council shall make during this period concerning programmes and subsequent activities in the field of research.

Article 3(3) of the regulation in question provides that the decision on any increase in the volume of the quota or the determination of the number of extra authorizations allocated to the Member States shall be taken by the Council, acting on a proposal from the Commission, by 30 November of each year.

It must therefore be provided that the Council, acting on a proposal from the Commission, shall be required to decide, by 30 November of the year preceding Greece's accession, on the number of authorizations to be allocated to Greece and on the total volume of the Community quota resulting therefrom.

(b) Apart from the amendments indicated above, the following adaptations must also be made:

- (i) in Annex I(a) and Annex II(a), "Greece (GR)" should be inserted between Germany and France in footnote 1;
- (ii) in Annex II(c) (as replaced by Annex I to Regulation (EEC) No 3024/77), "Greece (GR)" should be added in the footnote to the note on Column 5;
- (iii) in Annex III (introduced by Annex II to Regulation (EEC) No 3024/77), "GR" should be added in the second column against each of the present Member States and an additional entry should be made under "GR" (in the first column) with a list of the abbreviations representing the nine present Member States in the second column.
