

COMMISSION DECISION
of 22 December 1976
concerning the nomination of members of the Advisory Committee on Customs
Matters

(76/922/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to the Commission Decision of 7
November 1973 on setting up an Advisory Committee
on Customs Matters ⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 4 (2)
thereof,

Whereas, by the Decision of 21 December 1976 ⁽²⁾,
the Commission amended the composition of the
Advisory Committee on Customs Matters; whereas
this amendment has caused the nomination of three
new members of the Committee;

Whereas, in compliance with the provisions of the
second subparagraph of Article 4 of the Commission
Decision on setting up an Advisory Committee on
Customs Matters, the professional organizations
concerned have proposed, for each of the allotted
places, two candidates of different nationalities from
within the Member States of the Community,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The following shall be nominated members of the
Consultative Committee on Customs Matters:

Mr J. Van Gelderen (N), representatives of industry,

Mr A. Christopher (GB), representative of workers,

Mr R. Müller (D), representative of other parties
concerned with customs matters.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on 1 January
1977.
